2. Accommodation Offer from the Organisation Committee

For contestants and custodians

The Organisation Committee can offer attractive, reasonably priced accommodation and board for contestants and custodians during the World Championship from 8th to 20th July 2009. This is in the modern military barracks in Stans which is directly next to the competition area. You will find detailed information in the „Swiss Military Academy Accommodation“ attachment.

Offer No. 1 (180 beds / contestants and custodians):

Accommodation in rooms with 6-7 beds. Communal showers and toilets.

Female guests will be accommodated on a separate floor.

The rooms must be full, it is therefore possible that various nations will be sharing a room.

The cost for accommodation with full board is CHF60.00 or €42.00 per person and night.

Offer No. 2 (10 single and 45 double rooms / custodians):

Accommodation in single or double rooms with en suite bathroom. These rooms are in a separate building where the recreation and dining rooms are.

The cost for this accommodation, with full board, is CHF85.00 or €58.00 per Person in a single room and CHF75.00 or €52.00 per Person in a double room.

Full board includes three meals, self service.

The accommodation must be reserved in advance. To assist us in our planning please send us **your provisional notification by the end of April 2009**. This notification must include the approximate amount of contestants that will be staying in the military barracks. A prepayment of 50% of the total cost will be required for a reservation confirmation. Small changes can be requested until 30th June 2009. For cancellations the following costs will be charged:

Until 1st June 2009: 10% of the reservation costs, until 20th June 2009: 20% of the reservation costs. For cancellations after 20th June 2009 until the championship, 50% of the reservation costs will be charged.

Individual accommodation in hotels or holiday apartments must be organised by the participating teams themselves. Offers and information can be found at www.tourismus-buochs.ch or www.lakeluzern.ch.

For Supporters

A special camping area will be reserved for canoe supporters at the campsite in Buochs. This campsite is directly on the lakeside. Reservations must be made directly through <http://www.tcs.ch/main/de/home/tourismus/camping/platzsuche/buochs.html>

Hotel reservations should be made through the local tourist offices or direct with the hotels. A list of hotels can be found at www.tourismus-buochs.ch or www.lakeluzern.ch.

As this region is very popular with tourists, it is very important that hotel and apartment reservations are made as soon as possible.

3. Special Travel Arrangements for Non-European National Teams

Collection of National Teams from the Airports Zurich, Basle or Geneva

The championship organisers can arrange the transport of National Teams, which arrive by air, from and to the airports in Zurich, Basle and Geneva. The cost for the return trip is CHF60.00 (€40.00) per person with or without a boat.

The shuttle bus at the competition between start and finish and to the accommodation is included in this price. Transport offers (return trip) outside Switzerland are possible and the charge will be according to place and time taken. If this is required please contact the organisation committee by 8th June at the latest.

Boat Rental

So that problems with transporting the boats can be avoided, the organisers can rent boats to overseas teams.

Price per boat during the World Championships (8th – 19th July 2009)

- Wavehopper Perception (PE) used CHF 60.00 (€ 40.00)
- Viper by Probst (Diolen) new CHF 300.00 (€ 200.00)

These new Diolen-Viper boats can be purchased after the World Championships for a price of CHF 500.00 (€ 330.00).

This offer is only valid for a limited amount of each 10 boats. Teams which would like to take advantage of this offer should contact the organisation committee as soon as possible to make their reservation. This offer is only open until 30th April 2009 (first come, first served).

Excursions

On Sunday 12th July 2009 an excursion to a tourist attraction will be organised for World Championship participants (competitors and custodians). The team leader event on Tuesday evening will also be conducted in conjunction with a special tourist attraction.

4. Participation Fees

To cover the costs of all events on offer (excursion, dinner on the final evening, drinks at the opening ceremony etc.) a one-time fee of CHF20.00 (€15.00) will be collected from each World Championship participant (competitors and custodians).
